Welcome

Though we are in year B of the 3-year cycle of readings from the lectionary where the Gospel of St. Mark predominates, as we make our way through the Easter Season our Gospel readings, both on Sundays and in the weekday Masses, are taken from the Gospel of St. John.

St. John, the disciple whom Jesus loved, reaches his great insights into the life of Jesus in the light of Easter. The light of the Easter candle will burn next to the ambo from which we hear his Gospel in these weeks of Easter leading to Pentecost and the descent of the Holy Spirit.

There is a lifetime of meditation in St. John's eyewitness account, for us in hearing it and reading it, but also in the Gospel's development which is the fruit of a lifetime of meditation between St. John and Our Blessed Mother who was also an eyewitness to the life of Jesus.

From the hour of the cross St. John took Our Blessed Mother into his home; she would be his mother and he would be her son. She would live with St. John as his mother, and continue his formation as a beloved spiritual director helping him to understand so deeply what was in the heart of Jesus.

These greatest contemplatives would live in the same household for as many as 30 years until Our Blessed Mother's

Assumption. St. John would spend another 30 years shepherding the Church in Ephesus before writing his Gospel in the 90s of the 1st century.

Our Blessed Mother knew what was in Jesus's heart because it was also in her heart where she kept many things, often things that she didn't understand at the time they occurred. As she reflected on them with St. John it would help him in his experience as the bishop of Ephesus. How often things that we don't understand at the time that they occur remain in our hearts where the Holy Spirit helps us to understand their significance.

In writing his Gospel St. John calls special attention to the presence of Our Blessed Mother. In Cana at a wedding feast she called Jesus to the cross and then stood by him in his Passion.

We see Mary's influence, especially as a mother. Isn't it the way of a mother to minimize blame, to show the greatest understanding, and to make excuses for her children? As the shepherd of a flock it would be St. John's vocation to go after the lost sheep and care for them individually.

St John's Gospel sets before us the way of the beloved

disciple. We know that in his Gospel John is the beloved disciple, but in his humility he does not refer to himself by name, not even when he mentions the names of other apostles.

St. John knew that he wasn't the only beloved disciple, that Mary wasn't only his mother. He wanted us to know what is true: we are all children of Mary. And we should also think of ourselves as the disciple whom Jesus loved because Jesus thinks of us that way.

In Cana Jesus told Our Blessed Mother that his hour had not yet come. We see that the hour is determined by the Father and cannot be anticipated. How often, even in just one day, we can be surprised to be called to the cross of a real, concrete response to Christ-like sacrificial love. Isn't it the way for the disciple whom Jesus loved and the child of Mary?
