

To see the winter with fresh eyes, helps us to see the birth of Christ the same way

On December ninth we received our first snow fall of the winter season. It was uneventful I'd say for most of us, perhaps four inches, more than a dusting but not a big storm that would shut things down. For our new friend, Fr. Joseph Chacha Marwa, it was anything but ordinary. Though Father is in his 40's it was the first time in his life he has seen snow, other than on TV. As we walked between St. Monica Rectory and School the following morning he marveled at the glistening pure snow, clinging like glass to the bear tree leaves. It looked so pure, whiter than anything we can imagine. Though I enjoyed this beautiful sight what I enjoyed more was watching him take it all in. To see how he processed it all without any bias from previous years, without anything comparable to measure it, was amazing. I felt so blessed to be with him in that moment.

I thought if only we could see spiritual things as well as natural things with such fresh eyes. If we could imagine the angels singing over Bethlehem, Mary and Joseph with the shepherds gazing at the face of God as they admired and adored the baby Jesus. If only we could take all that in as if it were brand new. If this "good news" of the revelation of God in such a mind-boggling way could be brand new for us, what a Christmas we would celebrate! Perhaps then our loved ones that have passed on or live very far away from us, would not seem so remote. We wouldn't feel the pinch that so often touches our hearts when we are separated from those we miss so much if we could truly take on the significance of the one who leaped down from heaven to come to us. There is no distance God won't travel to win our hearts and convince us that he loves us every moment of our lives, but most especially when we are hurting in some way and are feeling acutely in need of love.

We are blessed to experience life here at St Monica and St Lucy with Fr, Joseph. He is quick to note the good here, very quick to see all the positives and the strengths of the life we share in our parishes. Fresh eyes are a good thing, whether the eyes of a foreign-born priest or the eyes of a child, they help us to see what is easy to overlook.

We have one week to go now to prepare to adore our Lord. Let us do it in a renewed way, whether it is our tenth Christmas or 80th, let us prepare to adore Him as if it were our very first.

Meet Father Cusack —


Embracing his vocation, embracing God's people
