REPORT CARD CONFERENCES for Grades 1-8

We have been receiving complaints that it is not running smoothly out there in Car Line 2. We will be monitoring the situation and if it does not improve, we will not be allowing students out that door and parents will be required to pick up children from the front parking lot. There will now be cones blocking the entrance to Car Line 2 at 2:00 PM. No car/bus will be allowed to enter after the cones are placed. Parents who are parking in Car Line 2 at the end of the day MUST wait until the teacher on duty removes the cones to move their car. You must stay parked and not moving until the cones are removed. Mrs. Tully will be out there today monitoring the situation and we will also be communicating with the teacher on duty to see how things are going. Also, no parent should be dropping off their child from that parking lot in the morning.
