



Concert opens St. Lucy's 6oth anniversary celebration

Members of St. Lucy Church kicked off the 6oth anniversary of the church's founding with a concert of prayerful, melodic and soothing Christian music by Gregory Norbert on Dec. 17. In addition to Norbert's inspirational music, magnificent icons painted by his wife Kathryn Carrington were displayed on the altar and throughout the church. The Rev. Bill Lohan, pastor at St. Lucy's, said Advent is an appropriate time to start the year-long celebration. St. Lucy and St. Monica Church make up the Methuen Collaborative. "Advent is the beginning of the church's liturgical year," Lohan explained. "It's important to remember our history and give thanks to those Italian immigrants who did not have much, yet set aside money to build this (church)."

St. Lucy is an offshoot of Holy Rosary Church in Lawrence, which started as Italians moved to the east side of Methuen. St. Lucy was established as a parish April 7, 1958. Groundbreaking for the church at 254 Merrimack St. was Oct. 12, 1958. While the church was being built, members worshipped at the nearby building that formerly housed the Chapel Furniture Store. The first Mass at the present church home was celebrated Dec. 19, 1959. The church is named after St. Lucia, known as the Patroness of the Blind. Her feast day is Dec. 13.

Bob Johnson has been attending St. Lucy for 29 years. "When you come into the church, you feel you're coming into a faith family," Johnson said. Cathy Rubino agrees. "Having people you know and consider part of your family around you, it's special when we come together," she said. Voiland said anniversary events will continue through 2018 including programs for children and veterans as well as one for souls in
