

### Easter - Fifty Days of Celebration

Friends our days of Lent and walking the passion of Jesus with Him have finally come to an end. We give thanks to God for the ways that we have grown in following the Lord more closely through works of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. As your priest, I am always so impressed by how many make the effort to get to Mass each day during Lent. What I also wish.....is that people would keep coming throughout the fifty days of Easter. As Catholics we have a very strong sense of the seasons of Advent and Lent, but often the importance of Christmas and Easter as <u>SEASONS</u> seems not to not be as present in the consciousness of many Catholics. The season of Easter is chalk full of readings from the Acts of the Apostles, the story of the early church and how the Apostles, filled with the Holy Sprit, brought God's love to so many. It is so important that we remember that our story doesn't end with the resurrection of Christ, that is the beginning for us, a beginning of a new life as a people of God. So many people in the Acts of the Apostles were just regular people like us but God captured their attention and their hearts through the works of the Holy Spirit operating in those first disciples. We continue our celebration right up to the great feast of Pentecost, 50 days after Easter Sunday, when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles giving them the gifts of the Holy Spirit and the courage to preach fearlessly.

I want to convey my thanks to all of the staff and volunteers who have worked so hard to make our churches and liturgies beautiful for this day, and this season. It takes many generous hands to do so much so well.

If you are new, or have been away from Church for some time, I want to let you know how happy we all are that you are here with us today and that it is our deep prayerful hope, that you will recognize just how amazing God is. He never tires of forgiving us as Pope Francis often says and He never tires of inviting us into a renewed relationship with Him and with our brothers and sisters in the Lord. Every Sunday is a "miniature Easter" as we recall the reality of the Lord's resurrection each and every Sunday morning. What a refreshing gift to know we can share in that resurrection each week to that we can bring the Lord our concerns, hear him speak to our hearts and have our hearts, minds and souls strengthened to engage the coming week with all the challenges that come to us at home, work and in our communities.

May God bless each of you and your families today and throughout the 50 special days that mark this beautiful season.


