I don't know about you, but I find it hard to believe that this Sunday marks the halfway point of Lent! It seems like Ash Wednesday was yesterday, to me. This would be a good time for each of us to look into how we have done in our commitment to prayer, fasting and alms giving. If we have done well, it is time to ask God for the strength to persevere. If we have not done so well, it is extremely important not to get discouraged. Remember that God always gives encouragement to us to do good, while he discourages sin. The evil one works the opposite way.

The liturgy of this Sunday is given to us as a means of encouragement. This is the Sunday called *Laetare* Sunday for the first word of the Introit of the Mass. it is akin to *Gaudete* Sunday in Advent. This is one of the two days of the entire year when the priest and deacon may wear rose colored vestments. We pray that Jerusalem and all who love her would rejoice, and that all who mourn would have joy. The organ and other instruments can be played more at this Mass. there may

even be flowers on the altar. The idea is that we should feel free to celebrate, and to thank God for all the blessings of Lent.

We also need encouragement as we move closer to Holy Week, and our commemoration of Our Lord's Passion. If we are strengthened in joy now, we should hopefully be able to unite in our sorrow for the sufferings of Jesus. In my experience, the liturgies of Holy Week are the only ones all year that actively elicit a strong emotional response. We are called to suffer just a little bit with Our Lord. Now is the time to prepare.

Let us also remember that there are many people among us who are suffering. Some are suffering terribly. Please pray for all who suffer, and to remember them at Mass.
