Not all gifts have big price tags

Here we are in the season of preparation for the greatest gift, Jesus sent by the Father to us. Of course we know that in the secular world this month is given over to a materialistic shopping frenzy. People stress out over the “perfect gift” others come to blows over the newest “cabbage patch kid” gift of the year. It is so important for us to remember we can give in beautiful ways that cost us nothing. This week two gifts came to mind, one involving each parish.

St. Lucy Parish celebrated the recognition of Shirley Jannetti receiving the Cheverus Award from Cardinal Sean O'Malley for her dedicated service to our parish for its entire 59 year history. She helps to keep the church and the other buildings clean. She is an institution in our parish and is beloved by all. Those who know and love her know that many could help clean our church faster and better, but no one could do it with more love. She says “I just want to help my church, that's all.” and so often she adds, “we're all different, everyone is different.” Shirley reminds us that God never values us in a utilitarian way, measuring only our production or output. God values us as St. Therese, the Little Flower would say, for doing little things with great love. Shirley puts St. Therese's “Little Way” into practice. She is a great gift to us, we are different, beautifully so!

St. Monica received a beautiful gift from Father Tom Gignac who spent his Diaconate internship with us, in both parishes. On the day of Father Gignac's first Mass of thanksgiving, offered at St. Monica, he brought his boyhood cassock and surplice with him (the black and white traditional boys' server attire, used at St. Monica). Luke Armano wore those vestments at Father's Mass. This week at a priest convocation, Father Gignac presented me those vestments as a gift to St. Monica Parish with a beautiful tag on the inside of the collar with his name and date of that first mass, also noting they were his boyhood vestments. How beautiful that Father would give such a precious gift to our parish! Countless servers will wear that and offer a prayer for Father Gignac! Those without faith might see only the passing on of 40-year-old clothing. But we recognize the love and significance such a gift entails. It cost Father nothing, he did not spend a penny, but a set of 10 new ones would not mean as much.

Perhaps our challenge over these next two weeks is to find ways to give great gifts that don't cost anything. Time is a gift, passing on something to a family member that has sentimental value is wonderful sign of love and affection. Making room in your heart and schedule for someone who is lonely or hurting doesn't cost a thing, but has infinite value.

Don't let the hustle and bustle ruin your Advent and Christmas. Christmas is a day of “Good News for all the people,” not a time to be stressed out over cards, turkeys, in-law's and traffic at malls. Let us prepare the way of the Lord, thank you to Shirley Jannetti and Fr. Tom Gignac for inspiring us to so.
