



FROM THE PASTOR

You may have noticed something missing from the Mass of the First Sunday of Advent. The most noticeable would be that we do not sing the Gloria during Advent. We wait until Christmas to sing that along with the Angels. Also, the decor is meant to be fairly simple: the violet color of the season tones down the sense of celebration. Advent, as we know, is a time of *preparation* for the Coming of the Lord.

We really shouldn't think of it as a month long countdown to Christmas; even less, a month of parties at the office or with groups of friends culminating in the Big Party on the 25th. Interestingly and oddly, all the work that we put into preparing for Christmas...the cards, the shopping for presents, the decorations...all the stuff that can be kind of frustrating and laborious, that *does* capture the correct feel in a way. Doing the hard work of preparing for something important, or rather, preparing for **someone** important to arrive.

That difficult preparation evokes the meaning of the first half of Advent, which is that we must always be preparing for the Coming of the Lord. His second Coming in Glory, that is. "Do not be caught drowsy...by carousing or anxiety," as the Lord admonished in last week's Gospel. However, in all things having to do with discipleship, we must also keep in mind that we can only cooperate with the grace of the Lord. It's ultimately not what we do, strictly speaking, but how we open ourselves to allow Christ to work in us. It is His work of preparation that we seek to not thwart.

Advent simplicity should set the tone in our preparation for Christmas. That's why you may have noticed one more thing missing from Mass during Advent. After the Communion hymn we will observe a time of silence in church. It won't be too long; just enough to clean the sacred vessels used at Mass and maybe a little silent prayer for the priest. It's an opportunity to sit in silence with Christ, whom we have just received, and to ask Him to change *in us* that which only He knows we need.



Infant Jesus Figurine blessing on Bambinelli Sunday

We would like to celebrate the third Sunday of Advent with more than just a pink candle this year.

We will adopt the Vatican tradition of blessing Nativity scene figurines of the infant Jesus.

Parishioners can bring their figurines to Mass next week for a blessing after the general intercessions.

Known as "Bambinelli Sunday" ("Bambinelli" is the Italian name for the figurines), the tradition was started by Pope Paul VI in 1969. Since then, the blessing has been given by the pope during the Angelus in St. Peter's Square on the third Sunday of Advent.






