#### FROM THE PASTOR

#### WHAT'S NEW IN THE NEW YEAR?

A lot, actually, but I thought perhaps focusing on one item is best. The uber umbrella topic is operations and management of two parishes and a school. Under there somewhere falls the scheduling of every item that happens in parish life. Somewhere under that falls individual event planning and financing. Finally, somewhere under there falls how many times a basket gets passed to you at Mass, someone is appealing to you for money either from the pulpit or in the announcements, or how often someone asks for a donation or offers a raffle at the entrance to the church. In short, my hope is to reduce the number of "asks" you get when your primary purpose is to come and worship God and receive His grace.

That's going to take a lot of thought because we do so many important and necessary works of mercy and parish life events that must continue and need funding. Slow change is best, then, but it starts somewhere. The easiest thing I can do on my own, right now, is to reduce the number of "special collections," meaning those offertory requests that are not of the weekly collection or Grand Annual, nor of the "second collections" or Catholic Appeal that is mandated to fund ministries beyond the confines of our parishes. So what's left?

Holy Days of Obligation. I figure if you're coming to church at a time of increased inconvenience, then your effort IS your donation. We can't remove all Holy Day collections because that adds up to more than you might think, so I'm starting with half. One, for example, is the Assumption the Blessed Virgin Mary. If you show up in the middle of the week on a hot August night, I figure come on in, cool off, and give praise to God and honor to the Blessed Mother. I won't be hitting you up for an entrance fee.

My best for a Happy New Year to you and yours.






# Priests have been a constant presence throughout our lives. **Boston Priests.** *Here for us.*




