The Office of Worship of the Archdiocese of Boston, in consultation with local health authorities, continues to encourage the clergy and faithful to observe necessary standard precautions to protect the health of others during this flu season. The best way to prevent the spread of contagious diseases is to practice good hygiene, such as washing your hands frequently with soap and water. In addition, the Cardinal directs the following for the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy and for flu prevention:

- The distribution of the Precious Blood for the faithful is suspended, with the exception of those who must receive from the cup due to medical reasons. The faith of the Church teaches that Christ, whole and entire, is received even under only one species.
- The exchange of the Sign of Peace is to be offered without any physical contact.
- Parishioners should be reminded that if they are ill or suspect they are ill with a contagious illness, they are not bound by the Sunday Mass obligation. They should remain at home and return to church when they are well.

<u>The Powerful intercession of Saints for Ordinary People in Ordinary Places</u>

In my first few days here in Methuen in 2013 we celebrated the feast of St. Lucy with a special mass as we do each year on December 13th. After mass I was introduced to a young woman, a native of Iraq, who was in the habit of making a pilgrimage all the way from Norwood each year for that special mass. She told me her story of being born in Iraq, coming to the United States, and having a very severe eye condition that was threatening her sight. She heard about our church back in 2010 and came to pray here before a badly needed eye operation. She was given tremendous amount not a encouragement by the doctors heading into the operation. It turned out to be successful well beyond the doctor's expectations. I offer a couple of other facts that make the story even better. The operation, without any manipulation of schedules at all, took place on December 13th, the feast of St. Lucy. Even better, do you want to take a guess at this young lady's name, her given name from birth in Iraq,....you guessed it, her name is Lucy! Most years on the feast she has returned to Saint Lucy to give thanks for her vision and to ask God to continue to protect her eyesight. The last two years she was not here and the Lucy parishioners who come to that mass missed her very much. Last week before the 11:30 am mass Lucy approached me to say hello with her husband Evan and her beautiful little son, Lucas.

Lucy now lives in Marlborough, which is also a fair distance from St. Lucy, but she had come once again with a large group including her mom, sister and other relatives to spend an hour in prayer in our little parish. The beautiful message for me of Lucy's visits to us is that any place, however ordinary, can be a special place of

pilgrimage. Any place can be a place where we feel God hears us and answers our prayers. If we wholeheartedly present ourselves before God anywhere can be special. We are so blessed to have two beautiful patrons, St. Lucy, for diseases of the eyes, and St. Monica the patron of parents, especially moms, who pray for their children. Let us who pray here all the time not overlook the gift of these patrons in our own holy places. Perhaps for us other places, a roadside Marian shrine we visited with grandparents, or busy urban shrines where parents took us for confessions when we were little, can be places that hold tremendous spiritual value. Lourdes and Medjugorje are wonderful, but even if you can't go there remember Lucy and her story and find that place that speaks to your heart. Go there and pray.
