

A New Sunday Morning Mass Schedule for St. Lucy Parish

Last night the Parish Council and I discussed the survey results from the St. Lucy parishioners regarding preferences for Sunday Mass times. The results were fairly evenly divided with a slight edge to the 9:00 and 11:00 over the 8:00 and 10:00. With the council's recommendation, and guite frankly it was my personal preference as well, we are going to go with the 9:00 and 11:00 schedule beginning the first week of Lent, Sunday February 18th. The decision to pick the later two times hinged on two key factors.

- The realization that for the long-term health of the parish the mass times must be as family friendly as possible. Both the 9:00am and 11:00am are family friendly mass times, whereas the 8:00 am hour is less attractive to young families.
- The convenience of the time for the meeting of parish social groups such as Our Lady's Sodality and the St. Joseph's Men's group. It was agreed that the 9:00am mass time was a much better time to accommodate these groups meeting after mass.

realize that this announcement is most disappointing to those who attend the 8:00am mass as they are asked to make the biggest sacrifice in coming to mass a full hour later than they are accustomed. Change is always hard but I hope that those folks, who are mostly older, can find it in their hearts to make this sacrifice for the sake of the younger families who need any and all assistance in this fast paced world to be able to get to mass. It is also good to remember that for those who really need an early mass that the 7:30am mass, with the same clergy, is available at our collaborating parish of St. Monica. Simply make sure you give either electronically or by envelope and your offering will be sent to your own parish of This new schedule features staggered St. Lucy. start-times between the two parishes adding great flexibility for parishioners of both parishes. If 6

everyone gives electronically or by envelope, neither parish will be hurt financially if folks cross parish lines to attend mass.

The parish of Saint Monica is also making a sacrifice as the 5:30pm mass, which was sparsely attended, will be discontinued as of the same date. reduction of weekend masses from nine to seven is an important step that allows us to keep our priests healthy, and allows us to make sure that liturgical ministers and accompanied music are present at all masses. The larger numbers of people attending mass together also presents a psychological boost for all of us as we pray in a more filled church with stronger congregational responses and singing. Seven masses for a Collaborative is also more in line with what is provided at other collaboratives, especially the ones that are single-language parishes like ours. Providing nine masses was simply not sustainable or healthy in the long run. Please know how much I appreciate your flexibility. It is a great sign of love and care for your own parish, your neighboring parish, and for your priests. I trust God will reward you for your generous flexibility.

Have complete dependence on God and submit to His will. In everything, look for His blessing and His quidance. Include Him in your plans. Don't leave Him out or you may miss out on some blessing He wanted to send your way. You may also miss out on His protection from some danger if you are fixated on what you want. After all, He knows the end from the beginning. God knows what you don't know. He sees every factor, takes into consideration all possibilities, and gives you the best option. God will show you the best route. You may see many possible courses of action, but from His perspective God sees the best path for you to travel through life.


