



Come celebrate with us!



I hope this finds you all well-rested and fed after Thanksgiving, in good spirits as we transition to Advent, and with pleasant thoughts of the approach of the Christmas Season. May whatever

cultural expression you await with excitement be fulfilling for you this year. That is, if you're a big fan of Black Friday or the Mall rush (or the exact opposite!), I hope it is in full swing for you. Personally, for example, I tend to stay away from the race of radio stations competing to see who can play holiday music the earliest, at least until after Gaudete Sunday (the day we light the **ROSE** candle and the priest wears ROSE vestments). Nevertheless, I have seen the most Grinch-like personalities turn to childlike glee when that first Christmas carol hits the airwaves sometime this weekend. Creating your own internet streaming channel on your own time just doesn't have the same effect as the change in the program lineup of the local station. That's the official ushering in of the Season because we are not listening alone, but with everyone else. I hope you know that joyful expectation in some way.

So, hopefully, you will maintain that joyful outlook as I announce a few differences this year in our Holy Day celebrations. First, given that it is definitely now the snowy time of year, we will plan to celebrate the scheduled daily Mass irrespective of whether school has been cancelled or not due to inclement weather. The one exception to this being an announced state of emergency or true blizzard conditions. This change will remove a few of the practical problems that come with randomly altering the Mass schedule, but it also brings additional responsibility on everyone's part. It is the obvious: if travelling in the weather conditions poses a safety hazard in any way, DO NOT GO OUT! In fact, it may be a good idea to use the old policy as a personal rule of thumb if you have any doubt. Please note that the Mass obligation is waved in those circumstances and, to be honest, acting imprudently is not pleasing the

Lord. That's the truth. Prudence is a virtue; it's opposite is folly and it is a vice. So I ask all of us to remind one another of these facts.

The other notable change has to do with the Mass schedule for Christmas and New Year (the Holy Day of Mary, Mother of God). On Christmas Eve we will NOT hold a Mass in the St. Monica School cafeteria, electing to plan for additional seating in the church and retaining the Mass in the Music Hall. A short way of explaining this change would be that it allows us to focus our limited resources on the Masses that we are celebrating for the 4:00 pm Vigil instead of spreading ourselves thin in a reactive way. All other Mass times in both parishes will be the same as last year. The further exception being Masses on the morning of January 1st. As we did for Thanksgiving, a 9:00 am Mass will be offered in each parish in honor of the Blessed Mother.

Finally, a wonderful ripple effect of having the cafeteria available that evening is that we are able to try something truly new and charitable. One of our parishioners has offered to host a potluck gathering in the school immediately following the Vigil for those with no plans for Christmas Eve. This opportunity is easy to misunderstand if we try see it through a typical lens: it is not a new parish social event for which we beg everyone to pitch-in and make a success. Nor is it an outreach effort to the less fortunate as such. It's an opportunity for those of the parish family to gather together on this holiest of evenings if they cannot be with their regular family or friends. As an example, I'll be there in between Masses. Let us pray that as changing seasons bring ongoing changes to our parish life, different approaches will bear ever more fruit for us as a people of faith.
