RENEW, REBUILD, AND REACH OUT: DISCIPLES IN HEARTFELT COMMUNION WITH JESUS CHRIST

From the St. Monica Director of Music

Lent is a season of renewal: renewal of our baptismal commitment to Christ through a renewal (or taking up again) of the traditional practices of Lent. These include a liturgical focus of simplicity and solemnity. In this spirit, we look to renew some traditional musical practices that will enhance our Lenten worship while introducing us to the most ancient and long standing music that the Church has written for the Most Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.


We have already started implementing the use of entrance and communion **antiphons** into some of our weekend liturgies. **Antiphons** are short chants with texts based on the Psalms and other lines of scripture that match the liturgical theme for any given week of the year. They are used to accompany the "processional" moments known as the **Propers** of the Mass. For instance, an Entrance Hymn at Christmas differs in melody and text from a Communion Hymn that we would sing for the Feast of Corpus Christi. From the earliest centuries of the Church, Catholic choirs around the world sang these Latin texts for the Entrance, Offertory, and Communion portions of Mass, largely in chant form, at every liturgical celebration throughout the year.

Once the vernacular (English) was allowed to be used at Mass, there existed no liturgical music based on English translations of the Latin Mass Proper antiphons. As a result, we have become familiar today only with hymns being sung at the Processional, Offertory, Communion and Recessional portions of the Mass.

Throughout Lent at *St. Monica Parish*, starting on Ash Wednesday, we will begin to use these antiphons *in place of* our Processional Hymn and, for the simplicity of the Masses during Lent, we will have no music during the closing Recessional. The procedure will be similar to how we sing the Responsorial Psalm every week: the refrain will be played once through on the organ, then sung by the cantor alone, then the entire congregation will sing the refrain together. The cantor will then sing through the antiphon itself as the celebrant processes to the altar. After the antiphon is complete, the refrain will be sung by the cantor alone once more followed by the entire congregation singing the refrain together again.

While all this may be new, these antiphons are actually pre-set parts of the Mass of the day just like the Responsorial Psalm and Readings are set. More importantly, they add more scriptural context to the liturgy, bring us deeper in contemplation of God's Word, and allow us to participate more fully in the riches of our faith. We are blessed at St. Monica to be rediscovering these often-overlooked antiphons thanks to the faith and support of our pastor and wonderful music ministers.




